- Lightweight, durable, cushiony and breathable ELASTY®, an excellent substitute material for urethane in a range of cushioning applications, such as bra cups, supporters and pads. It can also be combined with ECOPET® recycled polyester fiber as an environmentally friendly insulation material for clothing.

Also to be showcased is SOLOTEX® polytrimethylene terephthalate fiber, which is highly soft, stretchable, shape-retaining and durable. SOLOTEX® is partially bio-derived, so it also helps to conserve fossil resources.
