A material made of a combination of Teijin's heat-resistant aramid fiber and Kaneka Corporation's acrylic synthetic fiber with fire extinguishing capabilities. If it catches fire, the curtain carbonizes and prevents the fire from spreading.

MICROGUARD®

Plain weave texture with ultrafine microfiber. Owing to its high density, MICROGUARD® protects against mites and dust, without the need for chemical treatment.
