Teijin to Participate in Intertextile Shanghai Apparel Fabrics Show

Tokyo, Japan, October 18, 2013 --- <u>The Teijin Group</u> announced today that <u>Teijin Frontier Co., Ltd.</u>, the group's fiber-product converting company, and <u>Nantong Teijin Co., Ltd.</u>, the group's polyester textile manufacturing and processing company based in Nantong, China, will participate in <u>Intertextile Shanghai Apparel Fabrics</u>, which will be held at the <u>Shanghai New International Expo Centre</u> in Shanghai from October 21 to 24.

The two companies will exhibit a wide range of apparel solutions covering fibers, textiles and value-added fiber products, aiming to use the world's largest trade fair for apparel as a stage to promote their ongoing expansion both in China and the global market.

The Teijin Frontier booth (Hall W2, Stand E17) will feature a large collection of men's apparel fabrics, from suits to casual outerwear, developed with the Teijin Frontier's advanced converting capabilities.

The Nantong Teijin booth (Hall W5, Stand D06) will present high-quality polyester materials for applications such as casual lightweight down jackets, kitted sportswear and uniforms, including:

- Polyester taffetas made with Microft®, a moisture-permeable, water-repellent fabric produced with high-performance microfiber; and
- Knitted-shirt fabrics made with fibers offering special functional properties for heat shielding or adjustable ventilation.

Also presented will be ECO CIRCLE™, the world's first closed-loop recycling system developed by the Teijin group, which turns used polyester into new fibers that offer the purity and quality of petroleum-derived fibers.
