Advantages include rapid sweat absorption, fast drying and useful bulkiness. Octa™ Neo is a sheath-core fiber combining Octa™ long-filament fibers and other chemical or natural-staple fibers.

High-tenacity PASMO™ polyester material achieves superior comfort and body support based on a tensile strength that is 1.5 times greater than that of conventional materials.
