Thanks to its dense, flat-knit surface, DELTAPEAK® is a wonderfully multifunctional material that is highly evaluated by global sports-apparel brands. The booth will present many varieties of DELTAPEAK®, including glossy, high-tense fabrics made with advanced post-processing and high-function nylon-based fabric for athleisure -type fashionwear .
