Specific exhibits will include the following:

#### **DELTAPEAK®**

Teijin Frontier's next-generation fabric offers a well-balanced combination of softness, durability, elasticity, ultraviolet protection and anti-transparency. Wind-blocking properties can be added utilizing its dense, flat-knit surface. Nylon-based DELTAPEAK® also has outstanding abrasion resistance.

#### **Octa®**

This polyester fiber has a unique, highly modified cross-section with eight projections aligned in a radial pattern around a hollow fiber. Notable advantages include rapid wicking and drying, and useful bulkiness. Octa™ Neo is a multilayer fiber that combines Octa™ fiber with various chemical and natural staple fibers.

#### **ECO STORM®**

Waterproof and breathable material is made from chemically recycled polyester that is produced with Teijin's ECO CIRCLE™ FIBERS using close-loop recycling process. ECO STORM™, which comprises a laminated structure with a thin polyester film, also can be recycled into new polyester material.

#### **Fluorocarbon-free water-repellent materials**

Fluorocarbon, a halocarbon in which certain hydrogen atoms are replaced with fluorine, is a greenhouse gas targeted under the Kyoto Protocol. Fluorine buildup is thought to be harmful to the human body and the environment. Teijin Frontier develops durable and water-repellent fluorocarbon-free materials as part of its commitment to environmental protection.

#### **SOLOTEX®**

Teijin Frontier's polytrimethylene terephthalate fiber is highly soft, stretchable, shape retaining and durable. As a partially bio-derived material, it also helps to conserve fossil resources.
