Non-brushing and heat-insulating products that reduce microplastics will be exhibited, including a bulky, soft sweat-suit fabric and towel-like pile structure fabric from the DELTAPEAK® series. A bulky tricot material integrated with insulation and lining from the OCTA® series will also be on display.

Fluorocarbon-free Water-repellent Materials

Teijin Frontier will exhibit environmentally-friendly fluorocarbon-free materials offering durability and water-repellency, including a waterproof breathable fabric and a water-repelling polyester layer fabric that prevents sweat stain and reduces discomfort of sweat.
